Inspired by the Vietnamese proverb: "A teacher is an engineer of the soul," Sister Noel desired greatly to be "a teacher who could sow seeds of faith in the gardens of young souls." Unfortunately, the fall of Saigon in 1975 changed the course of her religious life, forcing her to risk four lifethreatening attempts to escape Vietnam, encountering soldiers, shooting, interrogation, deception, and Thai pirates throughout

those ordeals. By God's grace and protection, Sister Noel reunited with her family in San Diego in December of 1979 and rejoined her Vietnamese congregation shortly thereafter. In her effort to overcome her barrier to the English language, to better serve the community, and to grow spiritually and intellectually so she could resume teaching again, Sister Noel contemplatively requested to transfer to the Congregation of the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. She was elated and leapt for joy when her request was finally approved. She professed her Final Vows as an IHM Sister on August 15, 1987, choosing "Marie Noel" as her religious name in honor of the Blessed Mother, baby Jesus, and her favorite solemnity feast – Christmas. In her own words, "Just looking at Baby Jesus reminds me of innocence, joy, and peace."

Now welcomed into eternal life, we remember the joy she brought during her family visits to San Diego, memories which we will forever cherish. 


