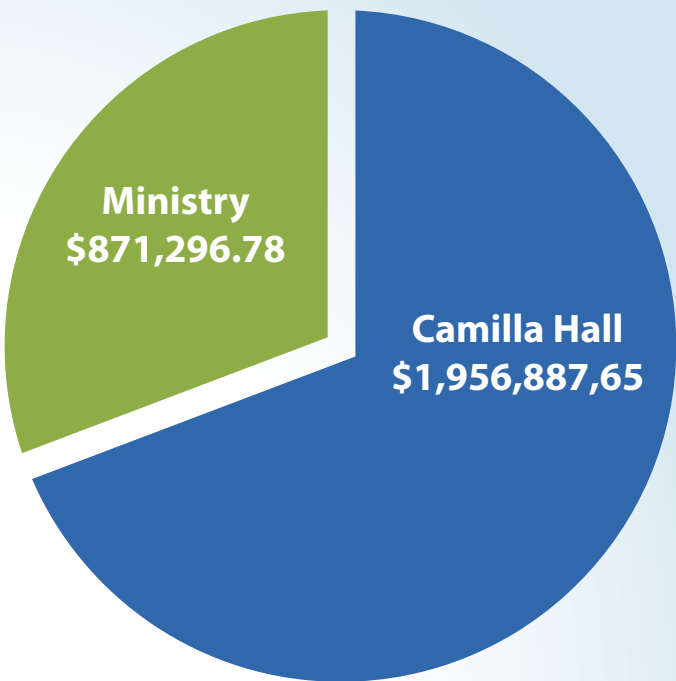

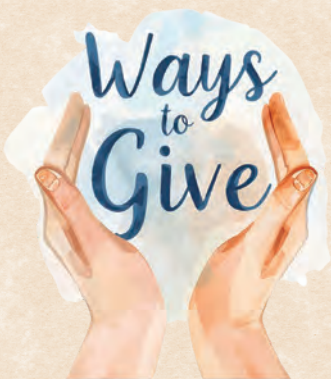

She was elated and leapt for joy when her request was finally approved. She professed her Final Vows as an IHM Sister on August 15, 1987, choosing “Marie Noel” as her religious name in honor of the Blessed Mother, baby Jesus, and her favorite solemnity feast – Christmas.
