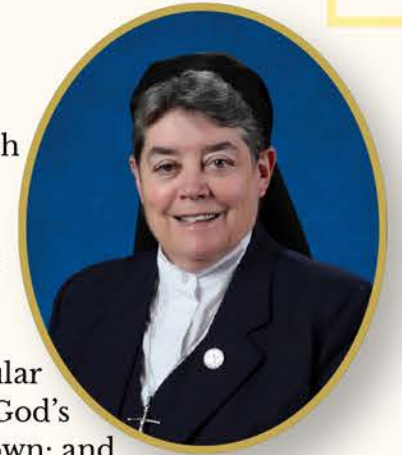
Sister took great pride in caring for our office plants. One Christmas cactus had no buds for the longest time, yet the day after her passing, it burst into full bloom with bright red flowers.

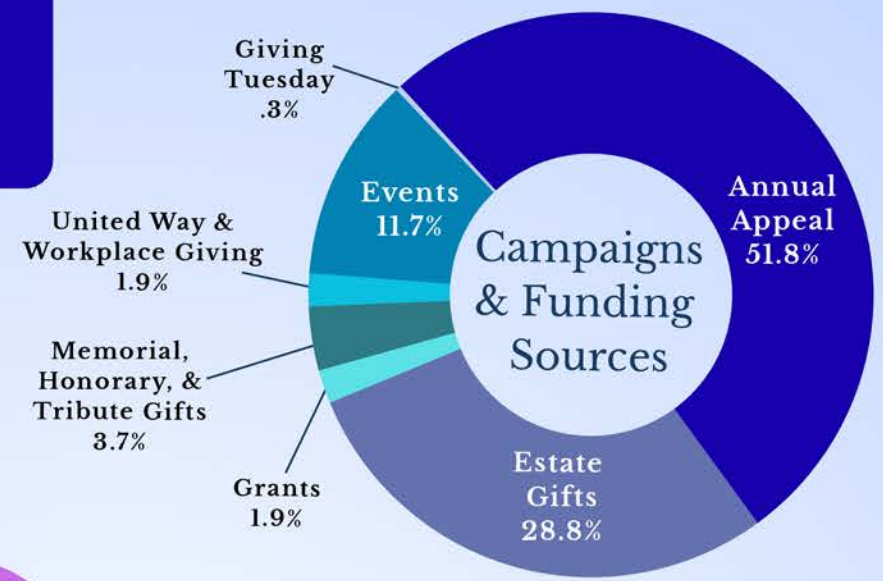
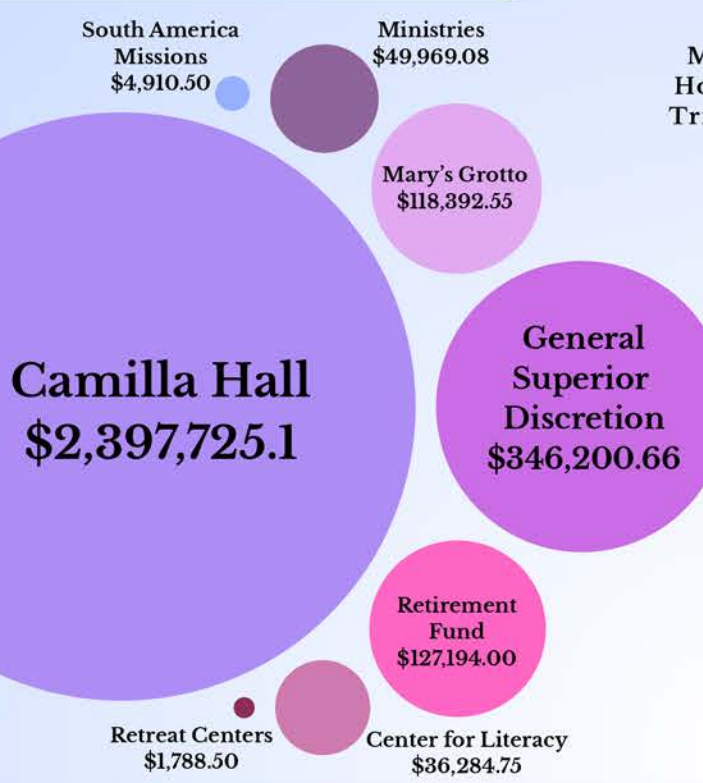

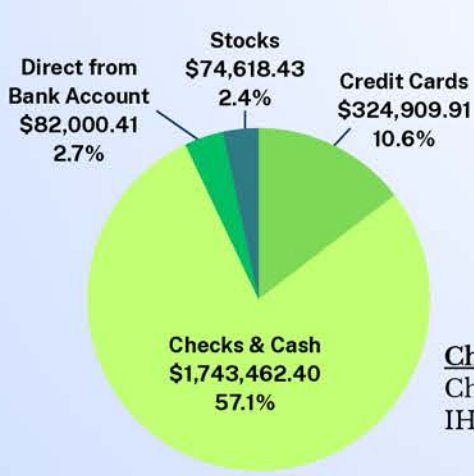

As we approach Fall, all hands will be on deck with our Sisters, staff, and many volunteers pitching in to prepare for the event. We are blessed with a wonderful Oktoberfest Committee planning everything from food, children's games, parking, and a variety of booths. 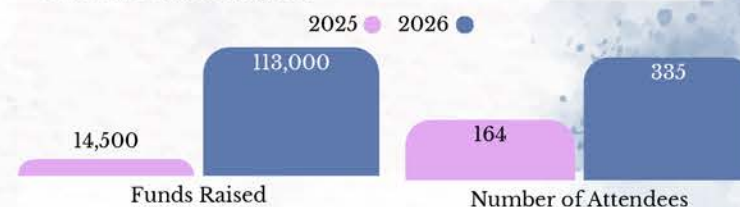
