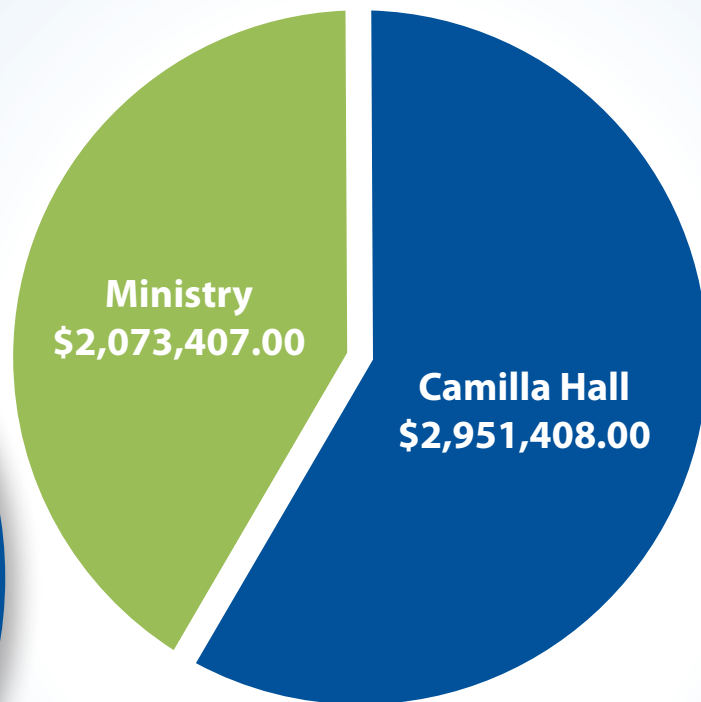

This report expresses gratitude for financial gifts, but it also honors immeasurable gifts of our 35 sisters who entered eternal life since July 2022. Our faith in the Communion of Saints, as referenced above, assures us these sisters and all deceased loved ones remain with us as one church. We say with heartfelt amazement, “We are who we are and do what we do because we stand today on their shoulders with their example and prayer.”

Just as our sisters support us from eternity so do those donors whose gift is listed as “Estate of...” naming the IHM sisters as beneficiaries in their wills; thus, their goodness reaches us beyond death. God’s goodness comes in gifts of all sizes, but this year the estate gifts have been an extravagant blessing which increased the advancement income to \$5,024,815 as shown on page 2.
