Essence Statement

God's Providence continues to create local communities that revitalize and respond to the mission of the Church. This belief calls us to:

- Reflect together as a local community on the meaning of responsible membership in our daily living.

- Be a peaceful presence in our interactions with each other, that we may be joyful witnesses as we love, forgive, and support one another.
- Participate openly and honestly in community faith sharing and daily conversations while actively listening to sisters. Address conflicts if they arise in a spirit of charity. Regularly discuss congregational communications to help each other stay engaged.
- Respect and celebrate the diversity of gifts of each sister with whom we live and minister, trusting that God's providence will use all our gifts for the greater good.
- Promote a spirit of hospitality that provides an atmosphere of inclusion and intentionally support, pray for, and show genuine care for each sister with her ministry, family, and community life.
- Take personal initiative for inviting and fostering vocations by seeking planned and spontaneous encounters with young women with whom we worship and minister.
- Enliven our commitment to fidelity in prayer and celebrating the Eucharist, striving to be a leaven of holiness to one another.
