Human Trafficking

January is **National Slavery and Human Trafficking Prevention Month**. On January 11th our country will observe National Human Trafficking Awareness Day. The tentacles of human trafficking reach into every city and region in our country. The recent influx of migrants, with unaccompanied minors among them, has created a population that is vulnerable to predatory exploitation. Human trafficking is a crime under state, federal, and international law. It is so pervasive, that only the illegal drug trade surpasses it on the international scene. There are three ways in which we can address this crime: 1. Pray for its victims. 2. Become educated in the forms of trafficking. 3. Be a responsible consumer; refuse to buy any product that was manufactured using slave labor or child labor.

The focus on Human Trafficking ends in February on the feast day of St. Josephine Bakhita, February 8th. St. Josephine Bakhita is the patroness of all victims of trafficking. This day is the <u>International Day of Prayer and</u> <u>Awareness Against Human Trafficking</u>.
