Expanding the Child Tax Credit can make a huge impact on the rate of childhood poverty in our country. It can: 1) Lift 500,000 children out of poverty; 2) Provide support to 16 million children in families below the poverty line and 3) Reach 1 in 5 children under 17, including 1 in 3 Black and Latino children under 17. This type of investment will have an especially important effect on communities that have been shut out of economic opportunity in the past.
