As budget reconciliation negotiations continue, there are lawmakers who want to shift the cost of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) from the Federal government to the states. Update on Haiti

Two Little Sisters of St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus, Sister Evanette Onezaire and Sister Jeanne Voltaire, sought refuge in a nearby house as the school in which they were working was attacked by the Viv Ansanm coalition of criminal gangs. Gang members found the Sisters' hiding place and shot them dead. A young girl sheltering with them received gun wounds to her chest. The gang also attacked the prison and other public buildings in Mirebalais, which is 30 miles northeast of Port-au-Prince. All the prisoners have escaped, and the city is controlled by bandits.
