Virtues of the Congregation

We may not be able to do great things for God as the saints did, but we can be humble in the knowledge of our helplessness."

St. Alphonsus: "True humility is not thinking less of oneself; it is recognizing our total dependence on God."

St. Teresa of Avila: "There is more value in a little study of humility and in a single act of it than in all the knowledge in the world."

We are all called to live a humble life acknowledging that all that we have and all that we are come from our loving God. We read in Scripture: "What do we have that we have not been given?" All is gift!
